Reflections chair: Maywood PTSA has a long history of participating in the National PTA Reflections program and showcasing the talent of our students. This is a National PTA program that encourages students to submit works of art in a variety of categories. The chair of this program would oversee the advertising, submission process, and judging (judges provided). Guidance will be provided as needed. There is an orientation training on Sept. 26 at 10:30am.
